CADETS SAILING COURSES @ CCSC for the 2003 Season

Once again we are able to offer courses for CCSC Cadets run at the Club by WOEC. In order for WOEC to cover their costs the cost has had to rise to £40.00 per day this year; however this still compares favourably with other establishments, and includes log books, certificates and the loan of lifejackets and boats if required. It is also a great advantage to be learning from our own base, especially after the move.

The range of courses this year (all RYA) are: Beginner, Stage 1 & 2, Stage 3, Red (sailing & racing).

Those that have completed Red are advised to arrange their next course (White /<u>Level</u> 3) direct with WOEC as a variety of boats need to be sailed to achieve higher levels. WOEC Courses are listed on the council website: dorset-cc.gov.uk.OutdoorEd (or 'phone: 01305 784927)

There are 6 Oppies and 6 Toppers (possibly not Fridays) available to borrow for Courses. Stages 1-3 will probably be run using Oppies; Red sailors can probably use Oppies, Mirrors or Toppers.

Experience has shown that half days work really well for 8 & 9 year olds, so the Beginners Courses will be run on 2 half days, plus 1 whole day. (10 year olds up will do 3 full days). Stage 3 and Red will be 3 days.

Please note: Beginners work on Stage 1 and progress to Stage 2 in the normal way; the course title indicates to us that they are under 10.

Dates: Sunday 25 May – Friday 30 May & Sunday 3 August – Friday 8 August

Courses will run for 2 half days plus 1 whole day or 3 days within these periods.

<u>Cost</u>: All courses will cost £40.00 per day (inclusive of Log Books, Certificates and boats – if required).
